Requirements

Applicants must be experienced in one of INGV's pertinent scientific disciplines, as documented by certified multiannual appointments in private or public universites, research centers and other national or international scientific bodies. Alternatively, they must have demonstrated multiannual experience in management and control for private or public universites, research centers and other national or international scientific bodies, with special emphasis on issues relating to the technologic transfer and to the evaluation of research results. Applicants must meet the general legal requirements of honourableness, and specifically they must enjoy full civil and political rights; they must not have been

convicted for a criminal offense nor have been removed from an assignment or let off duty for having forged official documents.

Application

Prospective candidates as members of the Scientific Council should apply in writing by sending a signed letter to the following address: Istituto Nazionale di Geofisica e Vulcanologia - Direzione generale - Via di Vigna Murata, 605 - 00143 ROMA.

The application must be accompanied by a curriculum vitae that includes all the following information:

- full personal data ;
- the main steps and accomplishments of the scientific and professional career (including bibliometric indicators when possibile);
- documents attesting that the applicant has the required experience;
- a list of other experiences relevant to INGV's scientific disciplines.

Under penalty of exclusion, it is mandatory that the applicant states in the application form under his/her own responsibility (as per DPR n. 445/2000) that he/she is in full possession of the civil and political rights; has never been convicted for a criminal offense; and has not been removed from an assignment or let off duty for having forged official documents. The release of false statements will be prosecuted and ratified by criminal sanctions under art. 76 of DPR 445/2000). Data privacy will be guaranteed as per the current legal regulations.

Deadlines

The application along with the curriculum vitae must be sent by certified mail ("Raccomandata") within 20 days from publication of this announcement on the INGV website. The date of application will be certified by the postmark. Should the deadline coincide with a holiday, it will be automatically postponed to the first following working day.

Activity of the Consiglio di Amministrazione

The *Consiglio di Amministrazione* will examine all applications and verify whether each applicant meets all the requirements specified above. Such verification will be based on the documents received and on additional available information. At the end of this process the *Consiglio di Amministrazione* will identify the three members for the Scientific Committee, one of whom may be selected also among experts in Economics. Then, based on the results of the elections held at INGV on 27 and 28 June 2011, the *Consiglio di Amministrazione* will appoint the new INGV Scientific Council.
